HERE'S HOW...


Step 1:

Launch our Library's Website Homepage (<http://www.lib.usm.my/>)


Step 2:

Once our library's Homepage is open, you will find the WorldCat Discovery link under Quick Link section.

See arrows on screenshots below.




Once you clicked, it will show the WorldCat Discovery search platform as seen below. Enter your desired search, for example "science".




Step 3:

You will see the result page as shown below. To select the Library source, Format and the Database; we are showing results from selection of: Universiti Sains Malaysia, full text and book types of format on WorldCat database.




Step 4:

Select the title result, for example, #33 "Montessori: the science behind the genius".




Shown below is the result page of your selection. On the left is the list of all titles' result, on the right is the selected title with description. Service will indicate whether or not it is available in your library. This page will show you, which other libraries hold the item if it is not available at USM.



Step 5:

If the title is held by your library, you can click the hyperlink "Universiti Sains Malaysia" at **Held by** and it will bring you to your library OPAC whereby you can check the availability, location and place holding.




Step 6:

If the title has a Google eBook edition, there will be a Google Preview button appearing. You may click the button to view the Google eBook for full text. However whether you can view the full text for the entire book or only certain chapters is at the discretion of Google.




Step 7:

If the title is an ebook or ejournal, there will be an Access online button appearing. Clicking the Access online button will bring you to the full text if you are within the campus. You will be redirected to Ezyproxy login page if you are outside the campus.
